

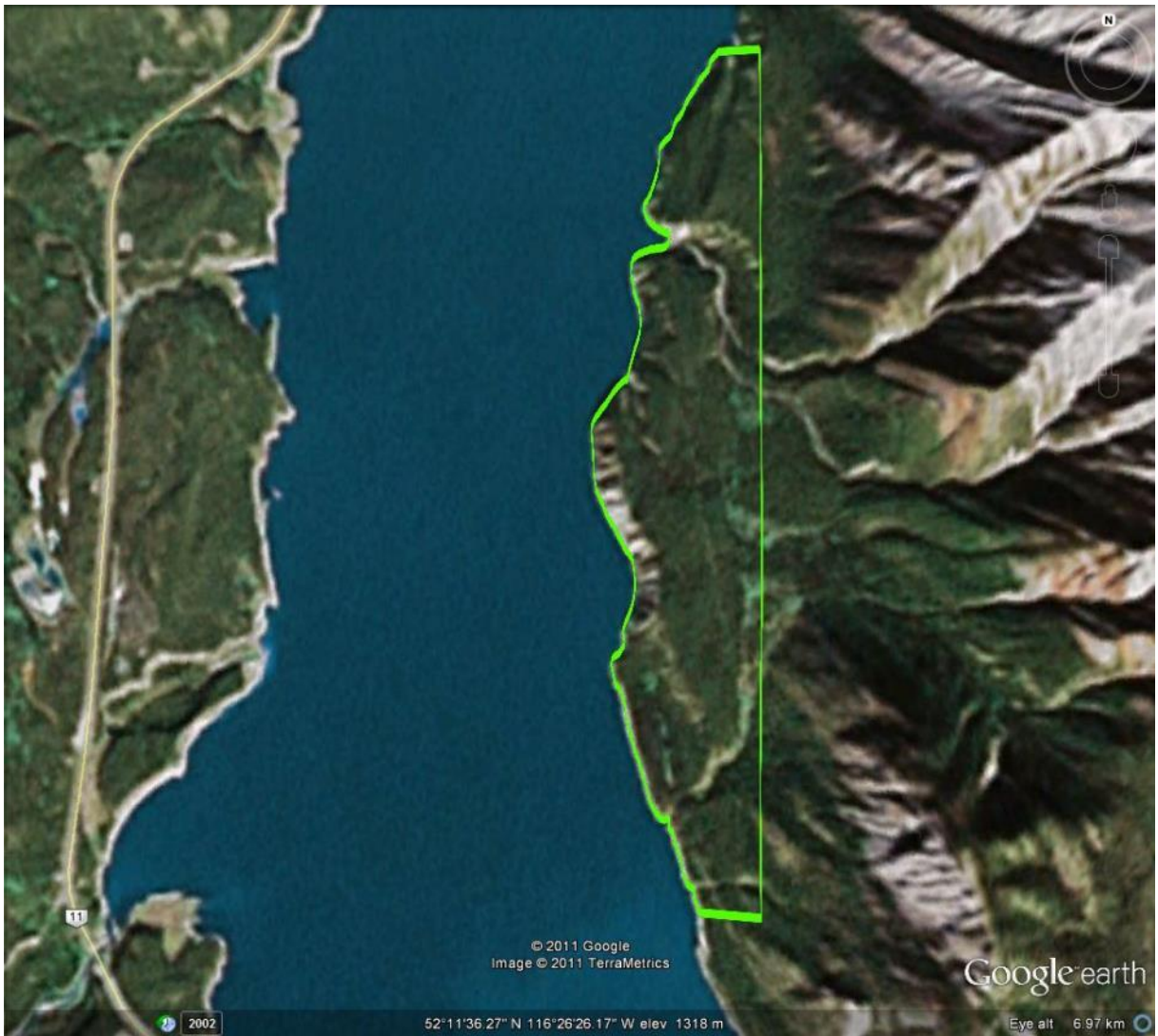

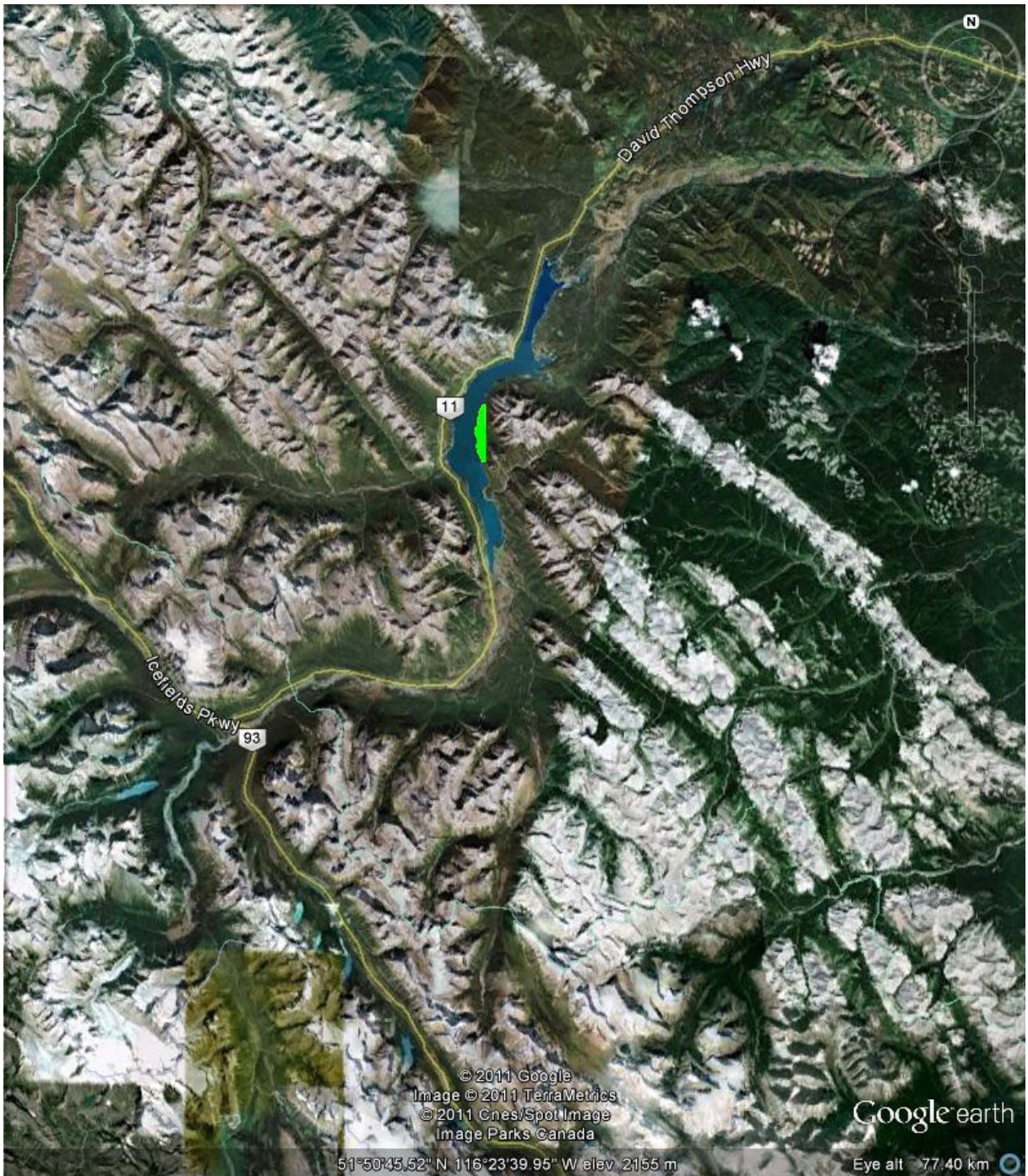

Notes: The Douglas Fir Natural Area (3.21 km²), located west of Rocky Mountain House, includes a stand of Douglas fir on the south shore of Abraham Lake. It has highly diverse plant communities, with abundant Douglas fir in pure & mixed stands; accessible by foot & canoe only; ungulate habitat.

This site is in the Rocky Mountain Natural Region, Montane Sub-region, which is well represented in Alberta parks and protected areas. The natural area was established or expanded as part of the Special Places program (Alberta Parks web site, 2012).
