Notes: This natural area (1.9 km²) consists of a creek valley-to-ridge top landscape that contains diverse vegetation communities. Limber pine is found along ridge tops while grasslands with groves of aspen & stands of white spruce are found on slopes. There are also beaver ponds & wetlands along Emerson Creek.

Emerson Creek NA lies Rocky Mountain Natural Region, Montane Sub-region. The Montane Sub-region is well represented in the parks and protected areas network (Alberta Parks web site, 2012).
