Notes: Lily Lake Natural Area has rolling topography with numerous wet depressions; mixed forests of aspen-balsam poplar-white spruce; willow shrublands; black spruce & tamarack/Labrador tea-dwarf birch wetlands.

This site lies in the Boreal Forest Natural Region, Dry Mixedwood Sub-region. The Dry Mixedwood Sub-region is the only Boreal Forest sub-region that does not have excellent representation within Alberta's parks and protected areas network. There are still significant shortfalls in the glacial lakebed, ground moraine, sandplain and sand dune natural history themes. Listed in "Other Natural Areas" (Alberta Parks web site, 2012).
