**Notes:** Magee Lake Natural Area (65 ha) is comprised of gently rolling aspen-covered uplands with a few wetland depressions and two gullies. It provides important wildlife habitat because of its link to Chain Lakes-Parlyby Creek system.

This site lies in the Parkland Natural Region, Central Parkland Sub-region. Fourteen level 1 and 63 level 2 natural history themes have been identified to describe the environmental diversity of the Central Parkland. Full representation of five of the level 1 themes has been achieved, but the remaining level 1 themes are not well represented within the parks and protected areas network. There is some representation of most level 2 themes within the network (Alberta Parks web site, 2012).
