**Notes:** Ole Buck Mountain Natural Area is a rolling, hilly site, slightly incised by creeks and gullies. It is mainly forested by a variety of mixedwood stands of aspen, balsam poplar, white spruce and lodgepole pine.

This site is in the Foothills Natural Region, Lower Foothills Sub-region. Five level 1 and 38 level 2 natural history themes have been identified for the Lower Foothills. With the exception of mineral wetlands, all of the level 1 themes are well represented in the parks and protected areas network. Level 2 themes are also well represented.
