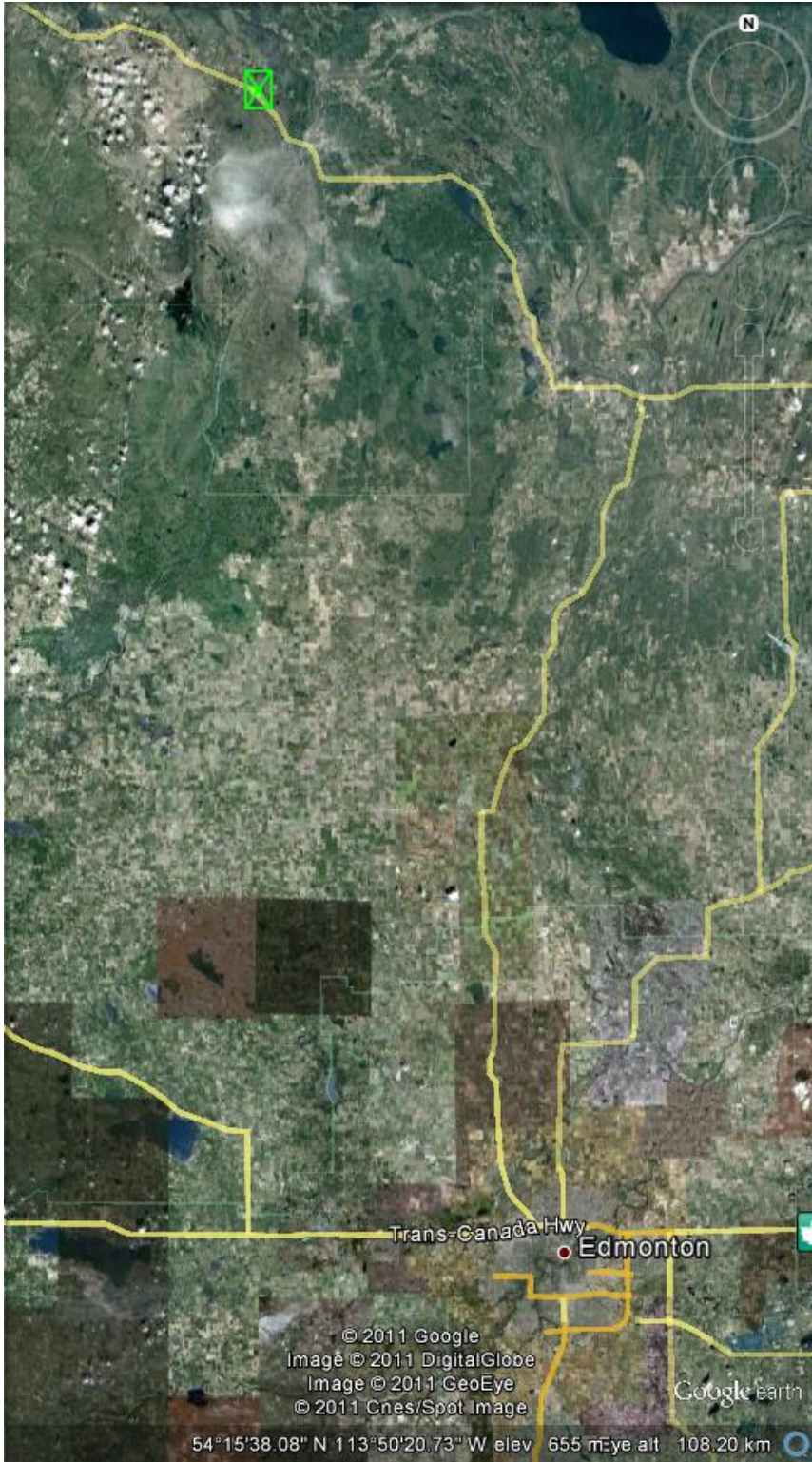
**Notes:** Saulteaux Natural Area (2.58 km<sup>2</sup>) is part of a group of natural areas [including Hondo (3.89 km<sup>2</sup>) and Otawau (2.56 km<sup>2</sup>)] that is used for research and study by the University of Alberta. Collectively these sites represent a diversity of forest communities with easy access of Hwy 2. Vegetation includes upland pine and mixed aspen and white spruce forest, with black spruce/Labrador tea/feathermoss forest in moister areas.

This site lies in the Boreal Forest Natural Region, Central Mixedwood Sub-region. There is excellent representation of all 11 of the level 1 natural history themes that define the environmental diversity of the Central Mixedwood Sub-region. All 48 level 2 themes are similarly well represented within the parks and protected areas network (Alberta Parks web site, 2012).
