**Notes:** Spruce Island Lake Natural Area (6.48 km<sup>2</sup>) consists of gently rolling terrain around Spruce Island Lake, Horseshoe Lake and numerous smaller water bodies and wetlands. The site lies in the Boreal Forest Natural Region, Central Mixedwood Sub-region. There is excellent representation of all 11 of the level 1 natural history themes that define the environmental diversity of the Central Mixedwood Sub-region. All 48 level 2 themes are similarly well represented within the parks and protected areas network (Alberta Parks web site, 2012).
