Notes: Sturgeon Lake Natural Area (28 ha) is an island at the west end of Sturgeon Lake. It is covered in mature forest and is used by great blue heron and bald eagles. The site is in the Boreal Forest Natural Region, Central Mixedwood Sub-region. There is excellent representation of all 11 of the level 1 natural history themes that define the environmental diversity of the Central Mixedwood Sub-region. All 48 level 2 themes are similarly well represented within the parks and protected areas network.
