

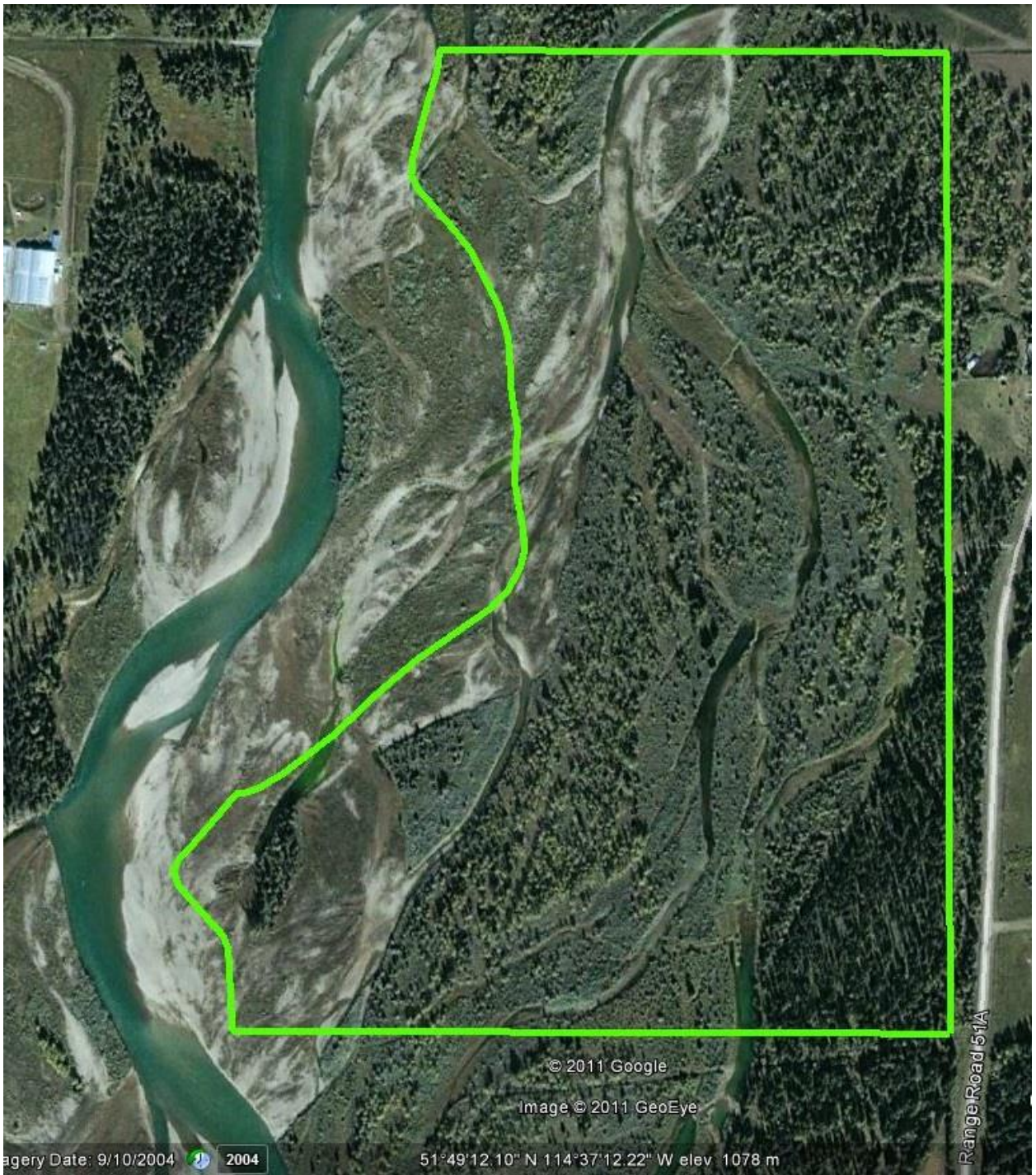

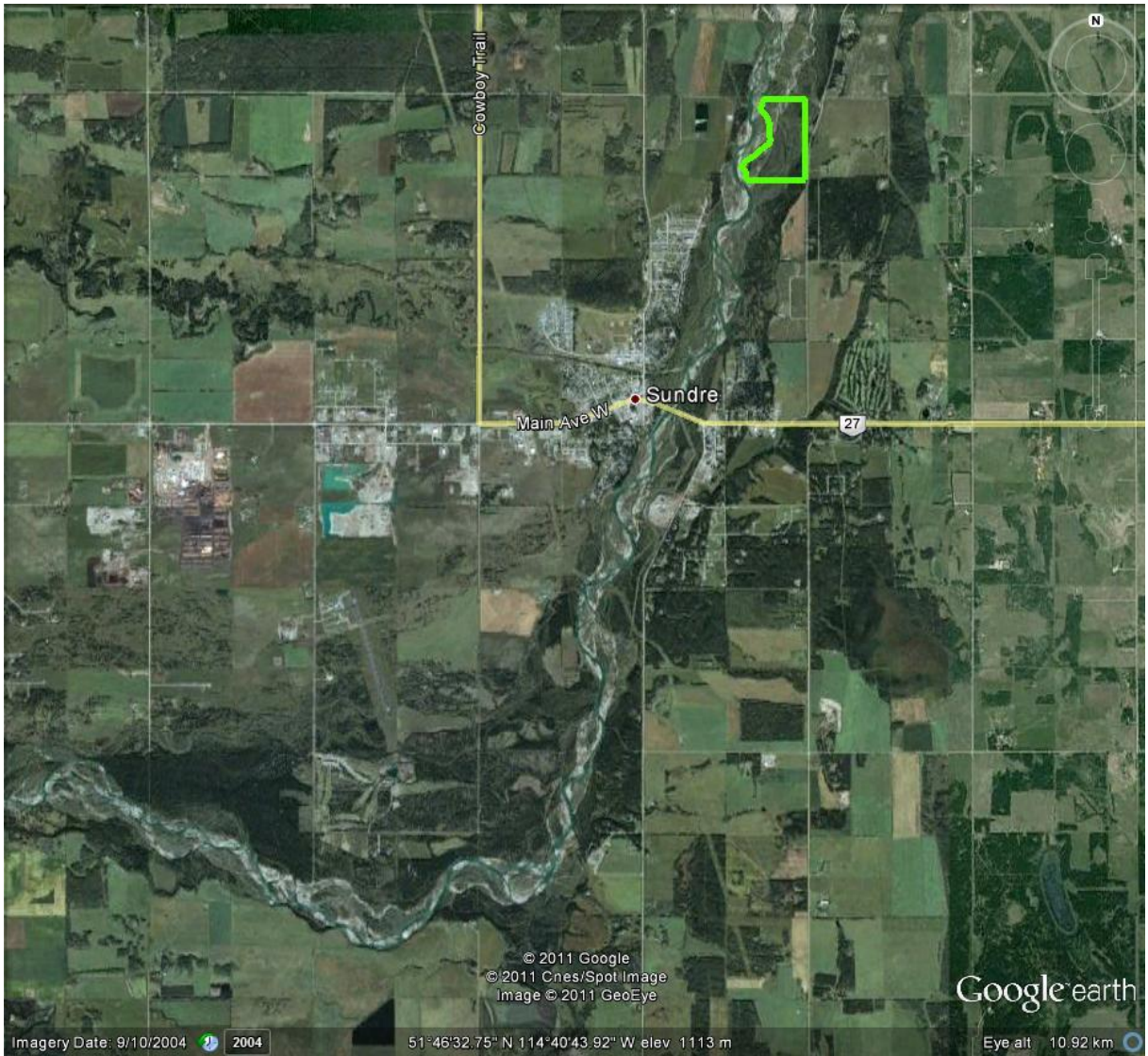

Notes: Sundre North Natural Area encompasses a section of floodplain and abandoned channels on the Red Deer River. Vegetation includes shrubland, aspen-poplar stands and spruce stands.

This site lies in the Boreal Forest Natural Region, Dry Mixedwood Sub-region. The Dry Mixedwood Sub-region is the only Boreal Forest sub-region that does not have excellent representation within Alberta's parks and protected areas network. There are still significant shortfalls in the glacial lakebed, ground moraine, sandplain and sand dune natural history themes. Listed in "Other Natural Areas" (Alberta Parks web site, 2012).
