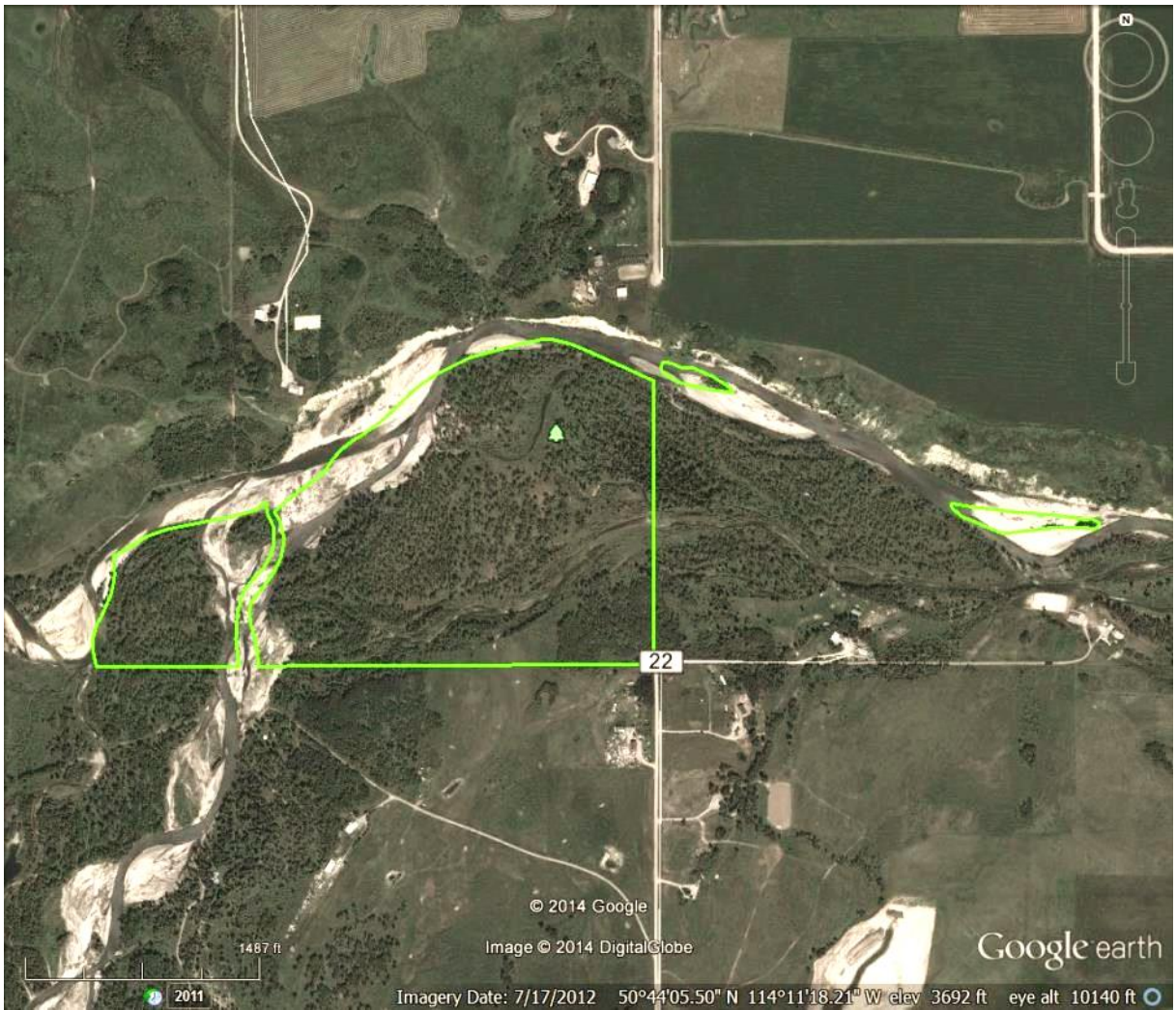


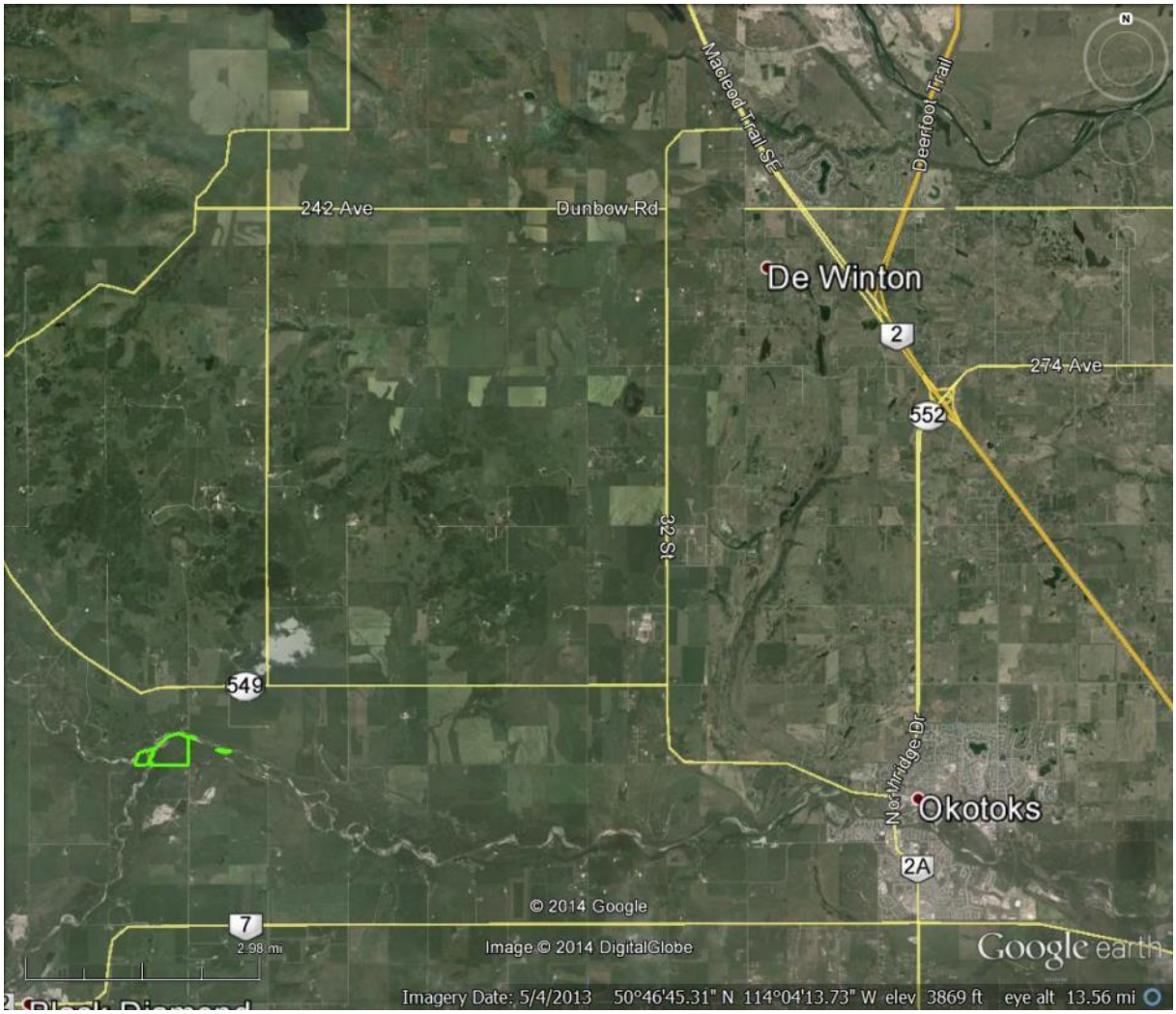

**Notes:** Threepoint Creek Natural Area Area (52 ha) is located at the confluence of the Sheep River and Threepoint Creek; it contains a great blue heron colony. This site lies in the Parkland Natural Region, Foothills Parkland Sub-region. The Foothills Parkland is the most poorly represented sub-region in the parks and protected areas network, with only slightly more than 20% of the level 1 targets achieved to date. There is some representation of all but 1 of the 30 level 2 themes that have been identified.
