

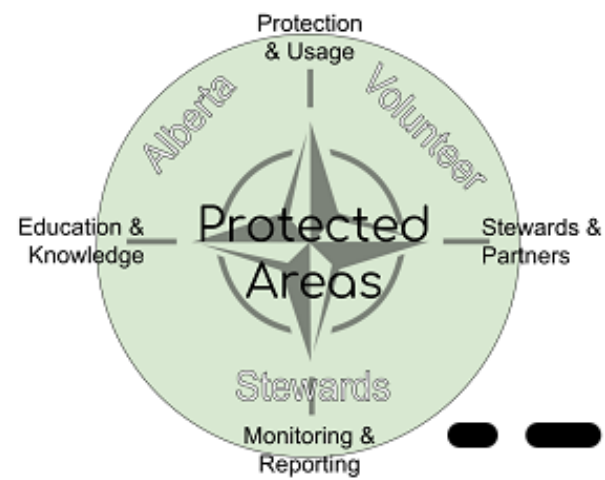

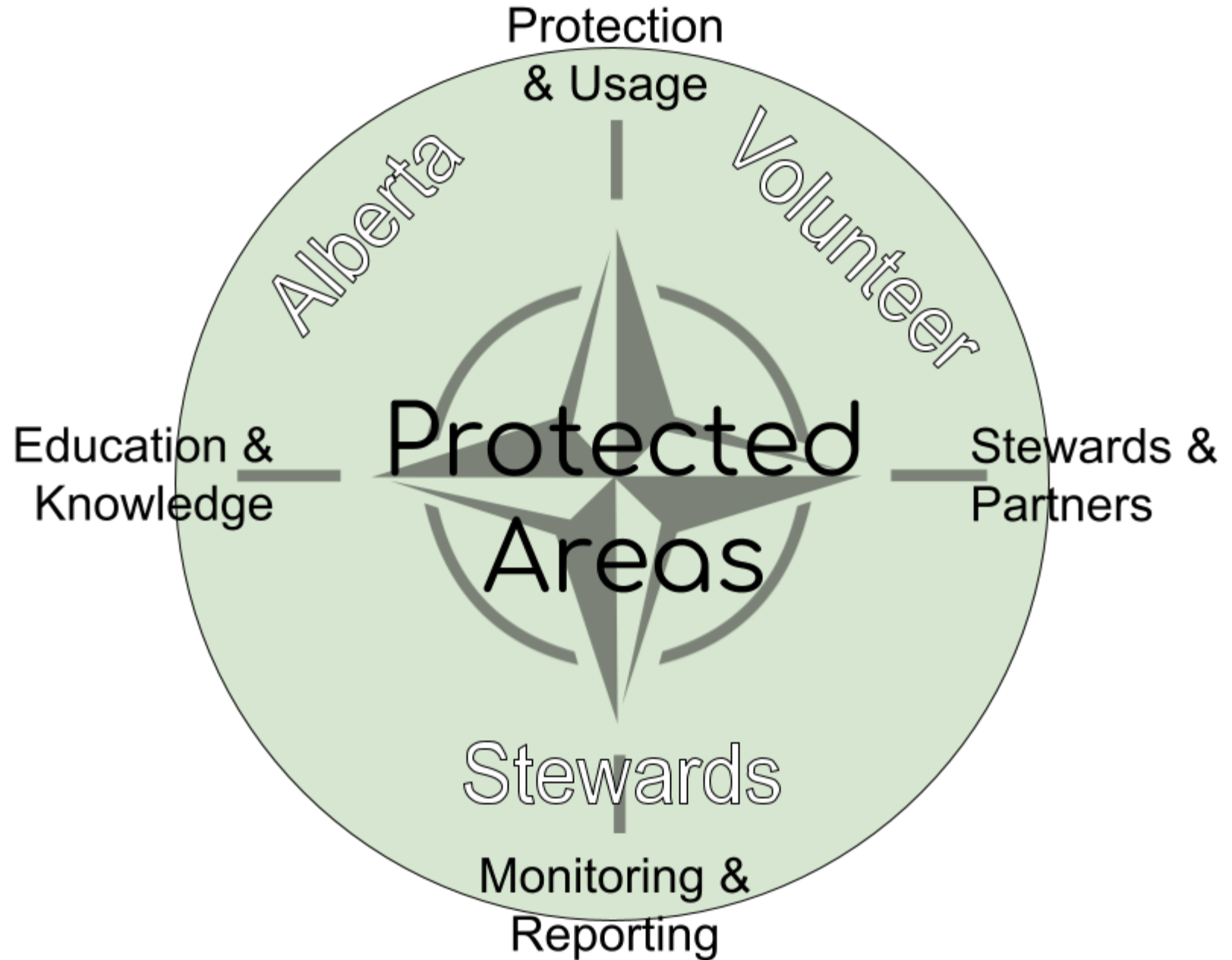

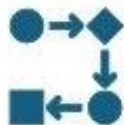
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Initiation – March '24

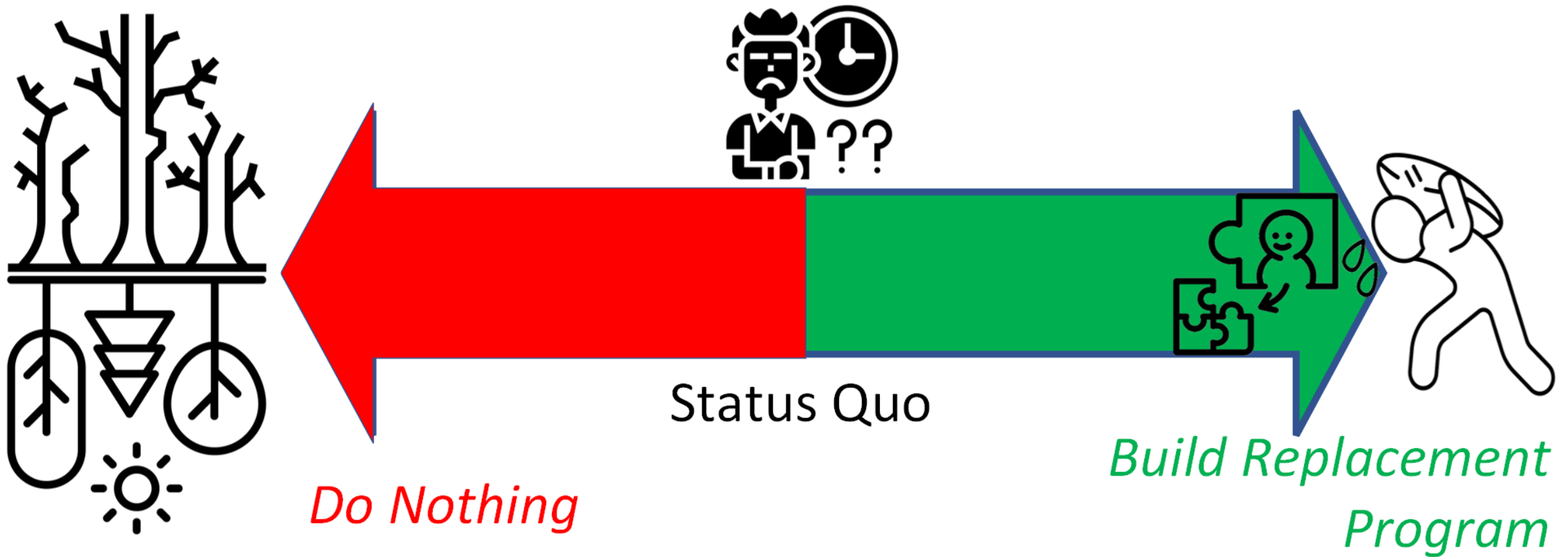

ALBERTA GOVERNMENT	Funding, Land Access, Information, and Programming	Credible information from the areas, access to safe & trained volunteers.
SAPAA	Existing Volunteers, subject matter expertise, testing	Continuation of the program, personal passion for the areas.
BIRKIE	Project management, infrastructure, Safety, Gov't Relations & Vol. Mgt	Re-use of select processes and technologies, covering fixed costs, using the 'story' in grant reports, communicating with the province.
NATURE ALBERTA	Primary contractor, governance, science, expansion of program, operations.	Larger volunteer program, funding, public visibility, govt. relations, access to data.
